CONFIDENTIALITY

The Carbon Reduction Institute Pty Ltd (CRI) requires the collection of data for the purpose of determining your carbon footprint. Your information will be made available to CRI staff and contractors only for the purpose of undertaking the emissions assessments. Following completion of an assessment (without undertaking any certification) or upon cessation of certification CRI will destroy all raw data collected for the assessment within 90 to 120 days following delivery of the report of cessation of the certification. Should you undertake certification then CRI will retain copies of this information.

All care will be taken to ensure the maximum accuracy of information presented in your emissions assessment report.

The Carbon Reduction Institute will not be held responsible for any cost, expense, loss or other liability directly or indirectly that arises from the use of information contained within the emissions assessment report, or any other communication (written or oral) about or concerning your emissions assessment.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By signing this form, you authorise the Carbon Reduction Institute to undertake a Carbon Emissions Assessment for your business. To enable the Carbon Reduction Institute to undertake the assessment, you are required to make all data required available to CRI. Your data will be handled strictly private.

INFORMATION NEEDED FOR MARINA EMISSIONS ASSESSMENTS

- Electricity bills for the last 12 months
- Gas bills for the last 12 months
- Water and sewage bills for the last 12 months
- Amount or cost of fuel purchased by the marina over the last financial year, split into fuel sold and fuel used by the marina
- Details of the volume of waste produced by the marina
- Completion of staff online travel survey, available on the resources page on the Low Carbon Marina Initiative's website <http://www.nocco2.com.au/marinas>
- Details of any large refrigeration or commercial chilling systems, specifically the type of system and amount of refrigerant gas they have in their system.
